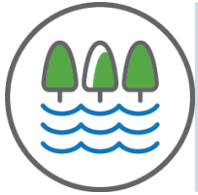

Julie Losinski

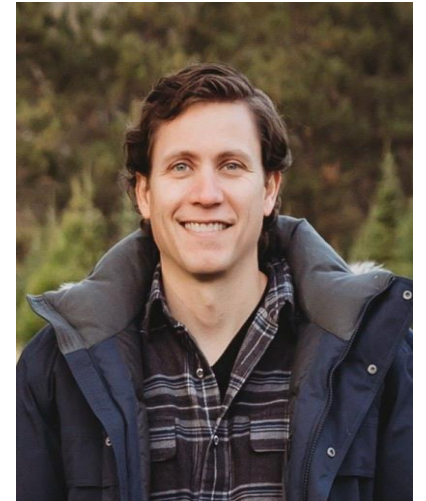

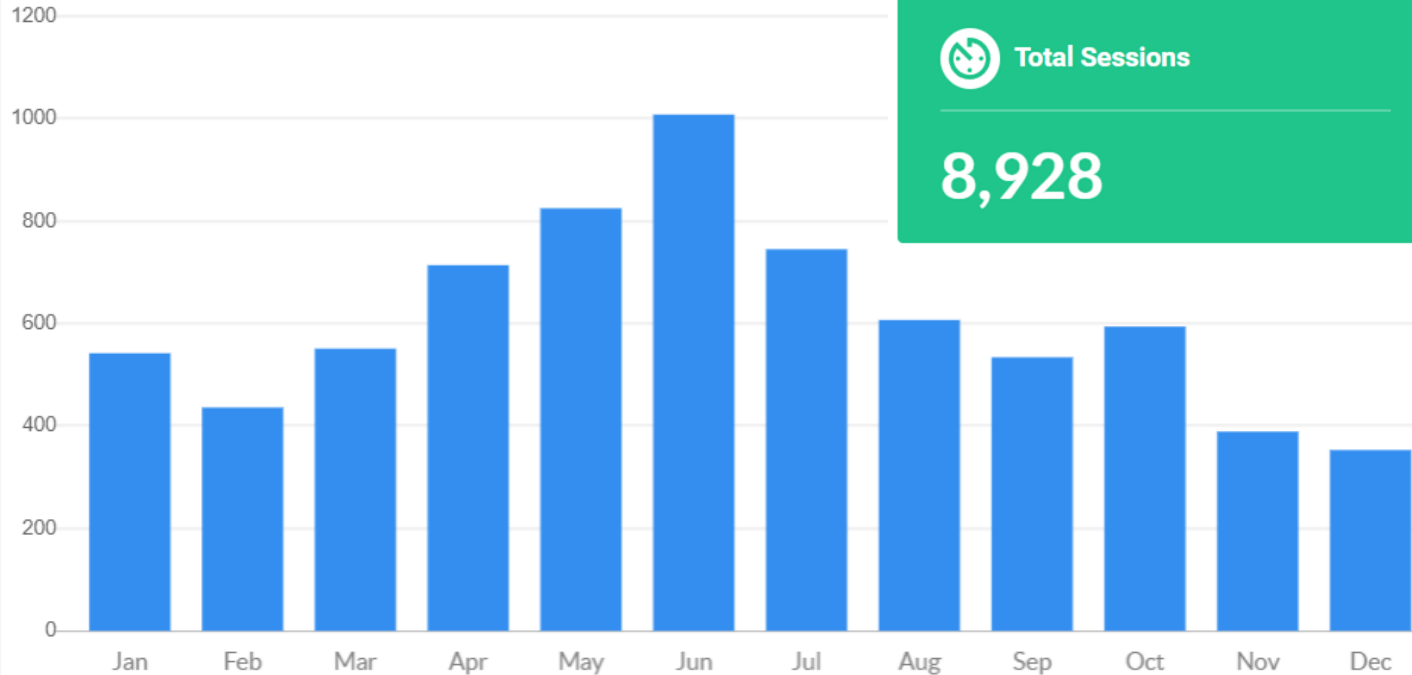

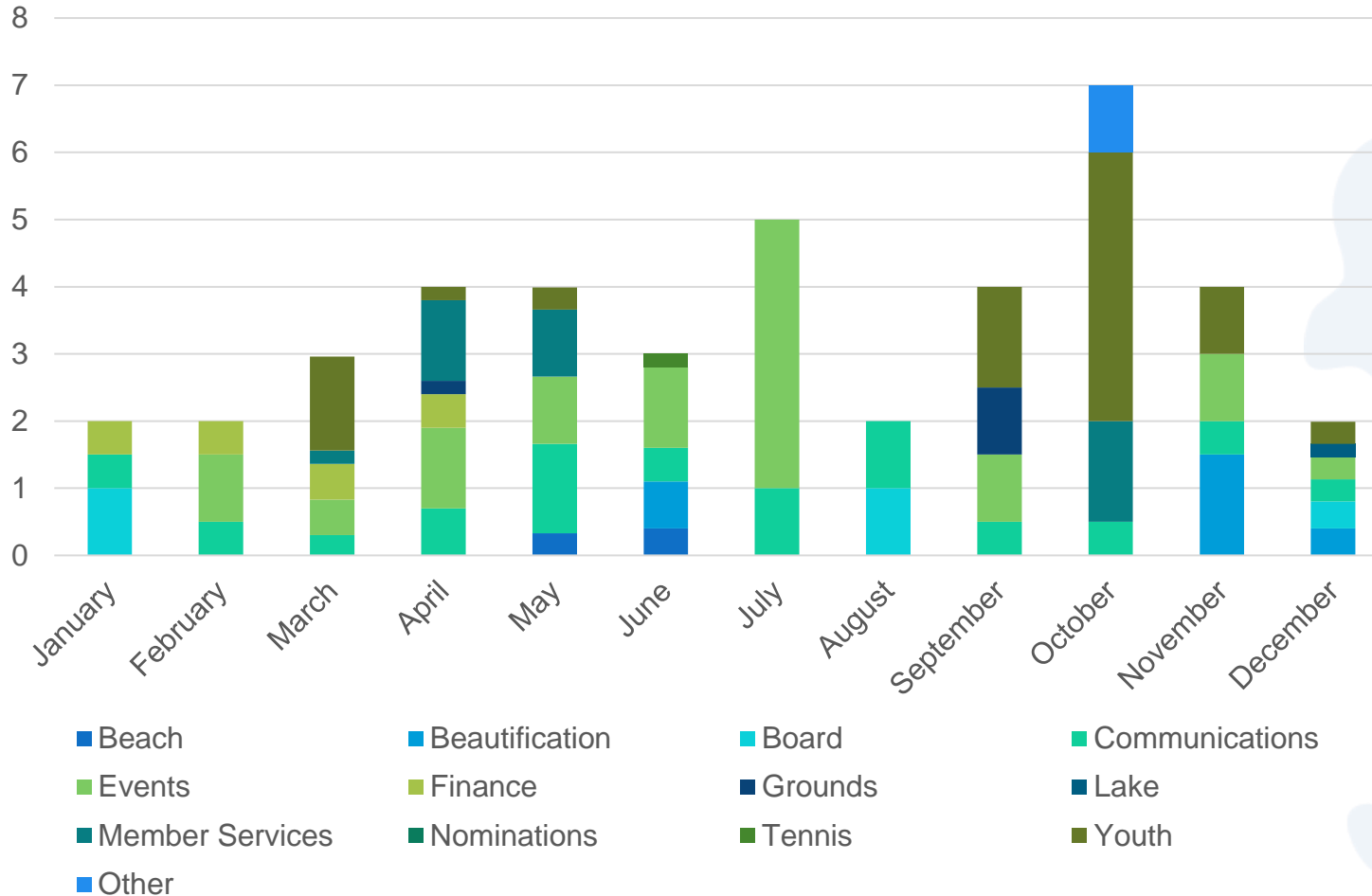

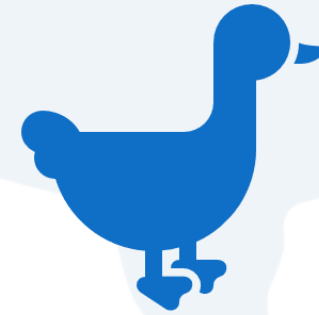
2023 Day-to-Day Actions

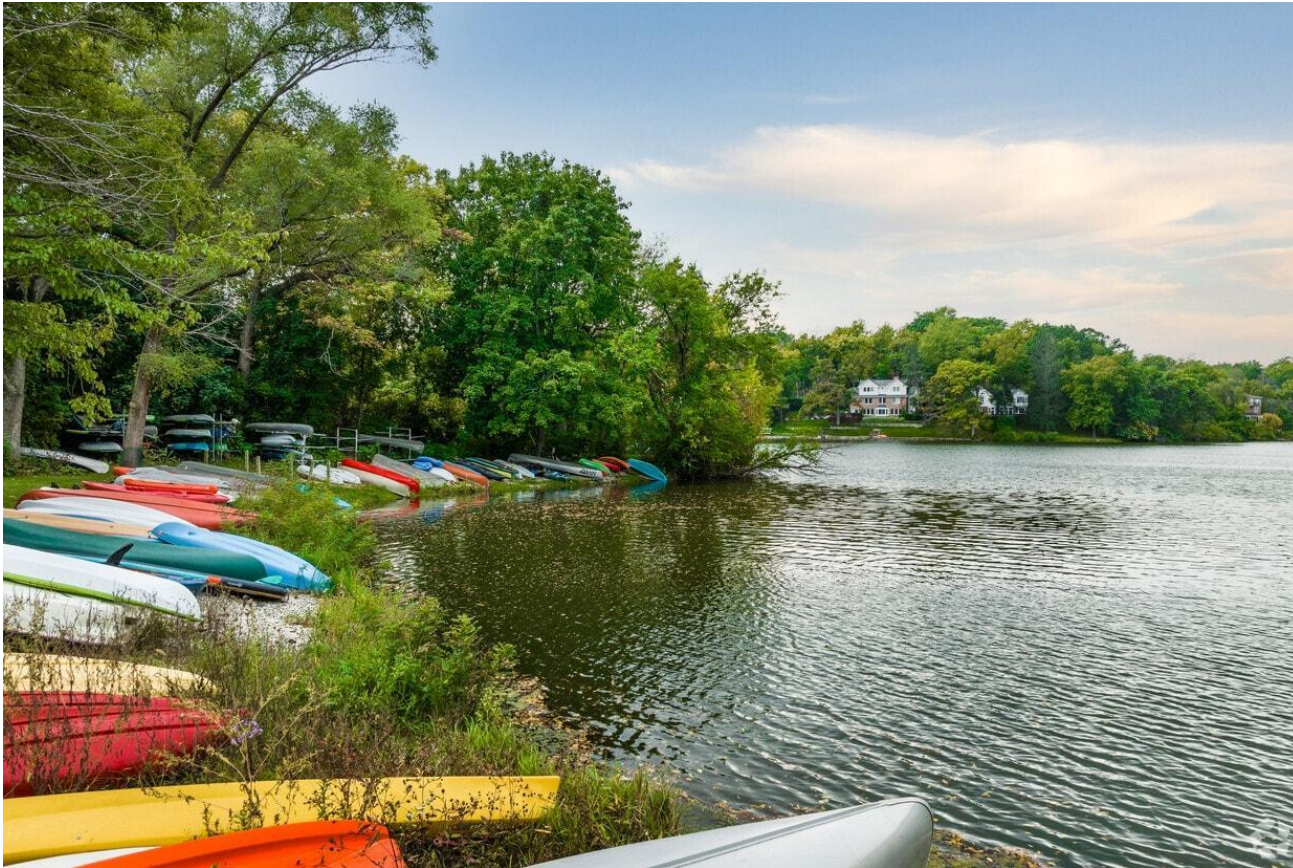

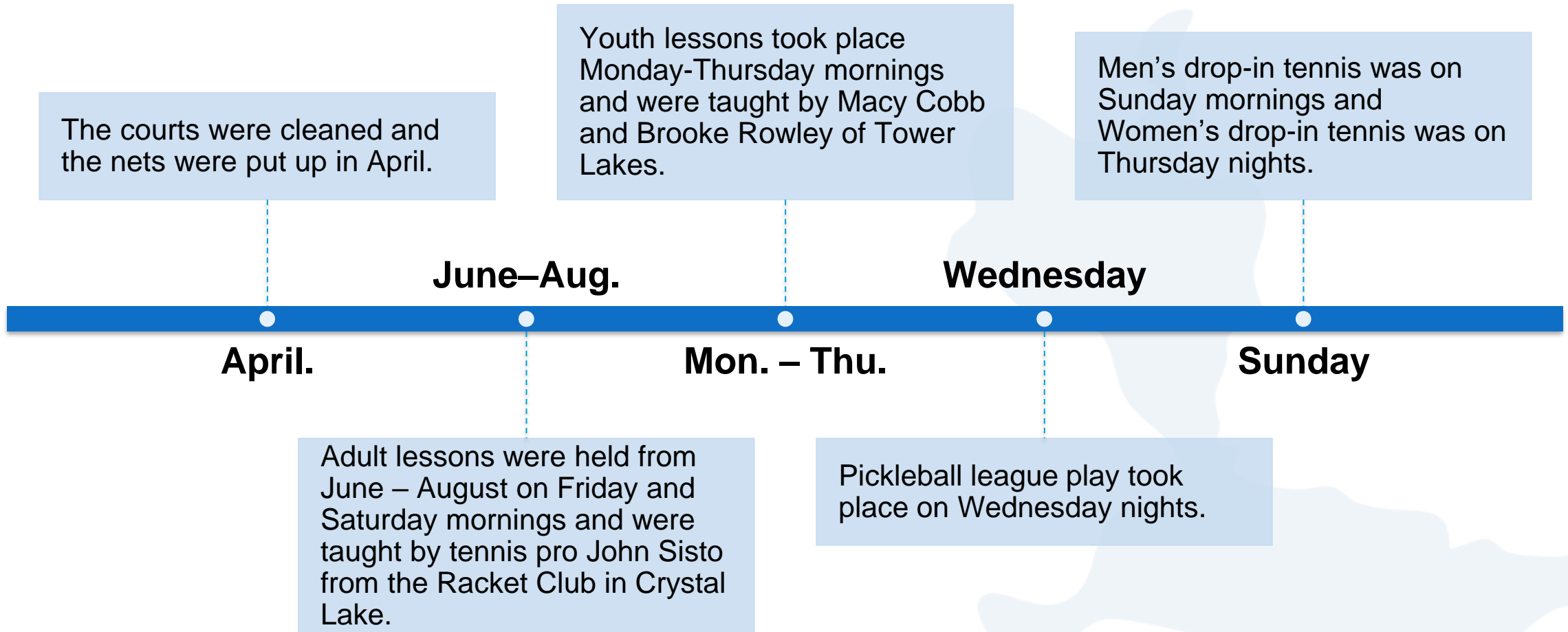
