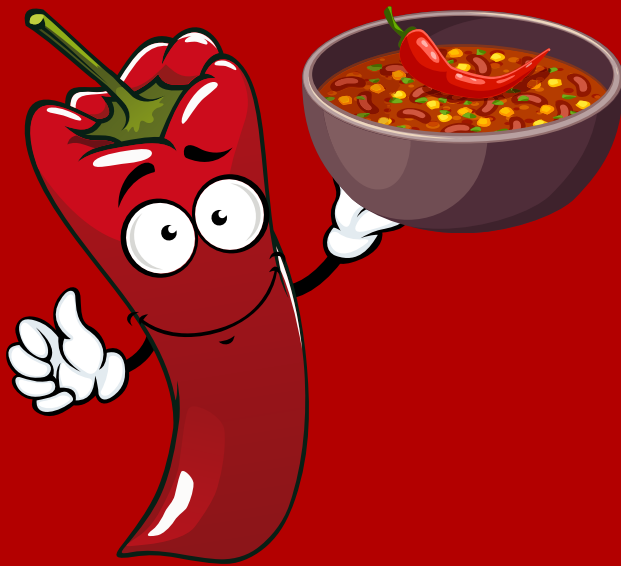

BRUSH PICK UP SERVICE the week of October 25

Have branches and brush stacked (no larger than 10'x4') with cut ends facing the road, and limbs no larger than 8" in diameter no later than **7:00 a.m. ON MONDAY, OCTOBER 25.**

DID YOU KNOW?

You can contact Cuba Township at 847-381-7793 if you have brush from a storm that you would like picked up on a day other than a Village-wide scheduled brush pick-up.

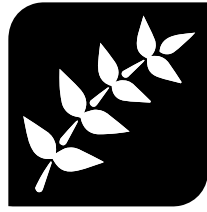

The Cuba Township offices are located just “up the road a piece” at 28000 W. Cuba Road, Barrington (just west of Rte 14 at Cuba Rd.) Call (847) 381-1924 and offer a variety of Services

Check out just some of the services that Cuba Township offers, ie:

- Lending Closet that provides orthopedic items including walkers, canes and wheelchairs to Cuba Township residents.
- RTA issued Reduced Fare Permits that allow seniors and persons with qualifying disabilities to ride at a reduced rate on CTA, Metra and Pace buses and trains.
- Pace/Dial-A-Ride Program: Subsidized by the Township for seniors and persons with a disability. The service offers local curb-to-curb service for \$2 each way.
- Passport Processing Services
- Voter Registration
- Notary Public Services: By appointment only, offered at no charge. Call (847) 381-1120.
